Open Course- Standard ISDS style single & double lift course.

Outruns – Maximum 500 yards, minimum 400 yards, Drive (+/-) 150 yards, Shed and/or single, Pen  
Nursery Course – Standards ISDS style course

Outrun – Maximum 300 yards, Drive (+/-) 125 yards, Pen

Any competitor whose bitch is in season must notify the Trial Secretary before starting time on the day the bitch is to run (ISDS rulebook). Bitches in heat will run at the end of the list of competitors in that class on each day.

**Directions from Edmonton:**

Take Highway 43 to Valleyview then at the Y Take Highway 49 toward Peace River. Go 15 km from the Main Street of Valleyview. At Township road 720 Turn Left. Go approx 1 1/2 miles and turn right into yard.

**Qualifications**

In order to compete at the WCST, all handlers must have been a paid member of a provincial association 30 days PRIOR to the commencement of the event. Members of provincial stock dog associations may not necessarily reside in the province; thus membership **not** residency determines eligibility.

Western Canadian Nursery Trial: A Nursery dog is eligible to compete if its third birthday falls on or after July 1, 2017. No other requirements except membership of a western provincial association by July 31, 2019.

The Western Canadian Double Lift Finals on Sunday September 29 will be the top three dogs in each open go round (chosen first), followed by top 4 aggregate scores as per the Western Canadians Championship Guidelines & Criteria. No dog will take 2 spots in the double lift, subsequent aggregate dogs will take the place of a dog earning top 3 and or aggregate scores.
